All trains on the Northern line have a mandatory stop in Aveiro, and there are also several bus routes that connect it to many cities in the country. To get to the *campi* of Santiago and Crasto, where all UAveiro departments, ESSUA and ISCA-UA are located, you can use the Aveiro Bus line.

If you prefer, you can choose to come on foot or by bike. Aveiro is one of the best cities for cycling, because it is very flat, and being a small city, everything is just a few steps away.

At UAveiro, spaces are identified by the numerical sequence "building . floor . room". If you find the designation "23.2.8", for example, you will have to go to building 23 (Pedagogical, Scientific and Technological Complex), go up to the 2nd floor and look for room 8.

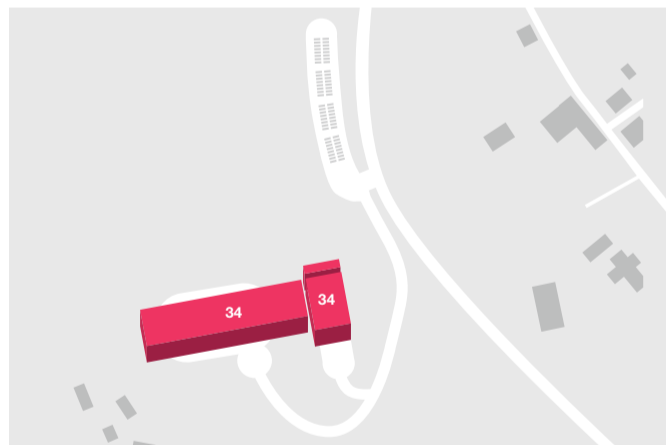
#### How to get there:

To get to ESAN, which is located in Parque do Cercal, in Oliveira de Azeméis, you can use Transportes Urbanos de Oliveira de Azeméis (TUAZ - Transportes Urbanos de Azeméis), and there are several other transport companies with regular connections between Oliveira de Azeméis and Porto, Aveiro or Coimbra.

It also has the Vouga railway line as an option, which connects to the Northern line at Espinho and the cities of Porto, Aveiro, Coimbra and Lisbon.

In Oliveira de Azeméis, the bicycle can also be a good alternative for traveling to Parque do Cercal

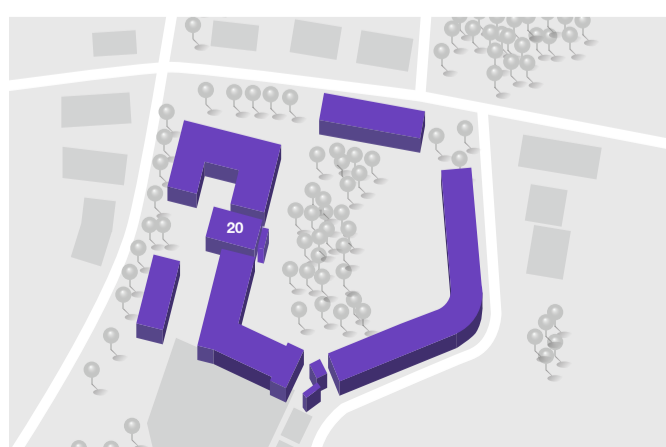
**20 ESTGA** – Águeda School of Technology and Management
