



Announcement

Special competition for international students to access and enroll in undergraduate degree programmes.

Academic year 2026/2027 – 1st phase

(Phase reserved for candidates who hold entrance exam certificates and/or national/state exam certificates recognised as substitutes for written exams)

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1. Applicable legislation

Decree-Law No. 36/2014 of 10 March, amended by Decree-Law No. 62/2018 of 6 August, amended by Decree-Law No. 20/2025 of 18 March, and Regulation No. 233/2014 of 9 June, amended by Regulation No. 874/2019, of 12 November, and Regulation No. 297/2021, of 26 March, which republishes the regulation of the special competition for access and admission of international students to undergraduate study cycles at the University of Aveiro, hereinafter referred to as the Regulation.

2. Places available and study cycles for which they are intended

Applications will be accepted for the study cycles identified in **Annex I**.

3. Students for whom the procedure is intended

This procedure is intended for international students, as defined in Article 3 of Decree-Law No. 36/2014 of 10 March, in its current wording:

- 3.1. All applicants who do not have Portuguese nationality;
- 3.2. All applicants who are not nationals of a Member State of the European Union or nationals of a State included in the Agreement on the European Economic Area;
- 3.3. All applicants who are not family members of Portuguese nationals, nationals of a Member State of the European Union or nationals of a State included in the Agreement on the European Economic Area, regardless of their nationality, in accordance with the provisions of Article 2(e) of Law No. 37/2006 of 9 August;
- 3.4. All applicants who have not been legally resident in Portugal for more than two years, without interruption, on 1 January of the year in which they intend to enter higher education, as well as their children who are legally resident with them;
- 3.5. All applicants who have been legally resident in Portugal for more than two years, without interruption, on 1 January of the year in which they intend to enter higher education, as well as their children who legally reside with them, hold a residence permit for study purposes, except in the case of students who are attending secondary education;
- 3.6. All applicants who, on 1 January of the year in which they intend to enter higher education, are not beneficiaries of equal rights and duties status granted under an international treaty between the Portuguese State and the State of which they are nationals;
- 3.7. All applicants who have not applied for admission to higher education through the special access and admission schemes regulated by Chapter II of Decree-Law No. 64-A/2023 of 31 July, namely, in relation to this competition:
 - a) National scholarship holders from Portuguese-speaking African countries;
 - b) Foreign officials from diplomatic missions accredited in Portugal and their family members residing here, on a reciprocal basis;
 - c) Nationals of East Timor;
- 3.8. All candidates who are not attending a Portuguese higher education institution under an international mobility programme to complete part of a degree of study at

a foreign higher education institution with which the Portuguese institution has established an exchange agreement for that purpose.

- 3.9. All applicants who, on the date of application, do not hold Portuguese nationality or nationality of a Member State of the European Union or nationality of a State part of the Agreement on the European Economic Area.

4. Conditions of access and admission

- 4.1. International students who meet the following conditions may apply for places available in the undergraduate programmes referred to in paragraph 2:

- a) Hold a qualification that gives access to higher education, understood as any diploma or certificate issued by a competent authority attesting to the successful completion of an education programme that entitles them to apply for and enter higher education in the country in which it was awarded;
- b) Hold a Portuguese secondary education diploma or legally equivalent qualification.

- 4.2. The conditions for admission to the places referred to in paragraph 2 are:

- a) Verification of the specific academic qualification for admission to the cycle of studies in question;
- b) Verification of knowledge of Portuguese, the language in which teaching will be provided in that cycle of studies, without prejudice to some degrees being taught in English in exceptional cases.

- 4.3. In the case of candidates who hold a qualification that gives access to higher education in a foreign country, under the terms of paragraph a) of no. 4.1., verification of the specific academic qualification is carried out by means of proof of completion of the entrance examinations provided in Annex I and referred to in Article 11 of the Regulations for the Special Competition for Access and Admission of International Students to Bachelor's and Integrated Master's Degree Programmes at the University of Aveiro.

- 4.4. Without prejudice to the provisions of the previous paragraph, for candidates who hold a qualification that gives access to higher education in one of the countries referred to in Annex II, the verification of specific academic qualifications in the relevant scientific areas may be carried out through the entrance examinations and/or national/state/international examinations listed in the aforementioned annex, and they shall be exempt from taking the written examination referred to in the previous paragraph.

- 4.5. In the case of candidates holding a Portuguese secondary education diploma or equivalent, verification of specific academic qualifications may be carried out by passing the national examinations, established under the general access and admission regime, corresponding to the examinations set out in Annex I.

- 4.6. International students enrolled in the 2025/2026 academic year in a UA study cycle who are eligible to apply in 2026/2027 may not apply for the same study cycle under this competition.

5. Written examinations per degree

The written examinations referred to in paragraph 4.3, related to each study cycle, are those listed in Annex I. The current application phase for the degrees indicated is only for candidates who meet the conditions for exemption from taking the exam under the terms of Annex II and also for candidates who have passed written exams taken at other Portuguese public higher education institutions, provided that the exams taken there are appropriate for the study cycle to which the candidate wishes to apply at the UA. To this end, the interested party must request the necessary verification of suitability from the jury of the study cycle to which they wish to apply, which can only be refused on the grounds of manifest unsuitability. To this end, the candidate must submit a request for the substitution of exams, attaching the certificate of approval and the respective syllabus.

6. Verification of knowledge of the Portuguese language

- 6.1. Knowledge of the Portuguese language is verified by proof, from any recognised body or entity, of level B1 of the Council of Europe's Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.
- 6.2. Knowledge of Portuguese is verified by presenting a certificate of approval at level B1 of the Council of Europe's Common European Framework of Reference for Languages, following an examination taken at a public educational establishment, when taken in Portugal, or at locations accredited by Camões - Instituto da Cooperação e da Língua, when taken abroad, or through a certificate in Portuguese as a foreign language issued after taking a test at a Portuguese as a foreign language assessment centre recognised by the Ministry of Education.
- 6.3. Knowledge of the Portuguese language may be verified through other types of certification that the jury deems equivalent to those described in the previous paragraph.
- 6.4. Candidates who do not hold level B1 of the Council of Europe's Common European Framework of Reference for Languages may, exceptionally, apply provided that they undertake, by means of a sworn statement, to attend an intensive course in Portuguese before starting the degree for which they are applying, under the following conditions:
 - a) Attendance of this course may incur an additional cost if it is taken at the UA;
 - b) Confirmation of enrolment at the UA is dependent on obtaining level B1.
- 6.5. Foreign applicants who have attended and completed secondary education in Portuguese are exempt from proving their proficiency in Portuguese, under the terms of paragraph 6.1.
- 6.6. The study cycles are taught in Portuguese, without prejudice to some degrees being taught in English in exceptional cases.

7. Prerequisites

Verification of the fulfilment of prerequisites is carried out in the same manner as for other students, namely within the scope of the general access and admission regime and in accordance with the provisions of Annex III.

8. Final classification

- 8.1. The decision regarding the ranking of candidates shall take into account the following:
- a) The classification obtained in the relevant scientific areas of the examinations taken in a foreign country and recognised, under the terms of paragraph 4.4, in the case of candidates holding a qualification that gives access to higher education in a foreign country;
 - b) The classification obtained in national examinations, established under the general access and admission regime, corresponding to the relevant scientific areas set out in Annex I, in the cases provided for in paragraph 4.5.
- 8.2. With regard to the provisions of subparagraphs a) and b) of the previous paragraph, the formula for obtaining the final mark is that established by the UA for the entrance examinations for the academic year in question, with the final classification expressed on a numerical scale of 0 to 20, calculated to the nearest tenth and, where necessary, rounded up or down to the nearest tenth, depending on whether the excess is equal to/greater than or less than 5 hundredths, with candidates with a final classification of less than 9.5 points being considered 'failed'. The procedures for calculating the final ranking mark are described in Annex IV.
- 8.3. The final result of the application is expressed by one of the following statements:
- a) 'Excluded' if the candidate does not meet or prove that they meet the conditions for admission referred to in Article 4(1) of the Regulations;
 - b) 'Not approved' if the candidate has a final score of less than 9.5;
 - c) 'Approved', if the candidate has a final grade equal to or higher than 9.5;
 - d) 'Placed', if the 'approved' candidate has an application score that allows them to fill one of the available places;
 - e) 'Not placed', if the 'approved' candidate does not obtain an application score that allows them to occupy one of the available places.
- 8.4. Candidates are ranked in descending order of their application scores, respecting the order of preferences expressed, with 'approved' candidates being considered 'placed' up to the limit of the number of places available for the respective study cycle.
- 8.5. Whenever two or more candidates are tied for the last place, additional places are created.

9. Disclosure of results

The ranking list of candidates is published on the UA website where candidates submitted their applications (<https://paco.ua.pt/candidaturas>).

10. Application process

- 10.1. Completion of the application form, available at <https://paco.ua.pt/candidaturas>;
- 10.2. The application process requires the following documents, which must be uploaded to the application platform (in PDF and JPEG formats). The documents listed below are mandatory and failure to provide them will result in exclusion:

- a) Upload of personal identification document or passport, CPF (for candidates with Brazilian nationality), which expressly states the candidate's nationality(ies); if the applicant objects to the reproduction/copying of the document in question, they must, within the deadline set for the application, present the document at the service desks, making the necessary appointment at <https://siga.ua.pt/>, selecting the entity 'Universidade de Aveiro';
 - b) Upload the diplomas/certificates of education/training of the qualification that gives access to higher education in the country where they were obtained and/or Portuguese secondary education or equivalent qualification, mentioning the grades obtained in the entrance exams and/or in the relevant scientific areas of the national/state exams, translated into Portuguese or English. In the case of diplomas/certificates of education/training that give access to higher education in the country where they were obtained, it must also be certified by the competent authority that passing the aforementioned training entitles you to apply for and enter higher education in the country where it was awarded;
 - c) Where applicable, proof of language proficiency, in accordance with Article 4 of the Regulations;
 - d) Proof of exemption from written examinations.
- 10.3. The form mentioned in paragraph 10.1 must contain the following information:
- a) Identification of the candidate, including their current residence status;
 - b) Academic qualifications;
 - c) Nationality or nationalities, in the latter case where multiple nationalities are involved.
- 10.4. Candidates may apply for a maximum of three study cycles, which must be listed in order of preference, with placement in a single study cycle.
- 10.5. At the beginning of the academic year, admitted and enrolled candidates must submit the required documentation in original format, duly authenticated, to the Academic Management Services (for qualifications obtained abroad, documents must be authenticated by the official education services of the respective country and recognised by the Portuguese diplomatic or consular authority or through an apostille issued under the Hague Convention).

11. Tuition fees and charges

- 11.1. The application fee is 70 euros.
- 11.2. The amount of the applicable tuition fees and charges is set out in Annex V.
- 11.3. Under no circumstances will application and registration fees be refunded. In the event of cancellation of registration, the provisions of Article 14(1) of the 'University of Aveiro Study Regulations' shall apply.

12. False Statements

Providing false statements will result in exclusion from the procedure, cancellation of the ranking or enrolment and registration, depending on the stage of the procedure at which it is detected.

ANNEX II: Recognised exams for the purposes of exemption from entrance exams

Candidates who can prove that they have passed one of the national exams listed below are exempt from taking the local entrance exams at the University of Aveiro. Only examinations taken in the last five years, including the year of application (in this case, 2022-2026), will be considered. The exemption applies provided that the candidate meets the minimum requirements defined for each examination in the respective country.

Brazil**ENEM (Exame Nacional de Ensino Médio/National Secondary Education Examination)**

– Exemption granted upon achieving a minimum score of 475 points in each area of the examination.

China

高考 Gaokao – Applicants with a score equal to or higher than 50% of the maximum score in their respective province.

高校联考 Liankao – Candidates with a score equal to or higher than 50% of the maximum score in the respective province.

Chile

PAES (Prueba de Acceso a la Educación Superior / Higher Education Entrance Examination) – Exemption granted upon achieving a score equal to or higher than 50% of the maximum score in each area of the exam.

Colombia

Saber 11 / ICFES Examination (by the Colombian Institute for the Evaluation of Education – ICFES) – Exemption granted with a score equal to or higher than 50% of the maximum score in each area of the exam.

Ecuador

Transformar – Exemption granted with a score equal to or higher than 50% of the maximum score in each area of the exam..

Evaluación Final de Bachillerato (Acta de Grado) – Exemption granted for a minimum score equal to or greater than 50% of the maximum score on the exam taken.

Hong Kong

HKDSE (Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination) – Exemption granted for a minimum score of 1 point in each area/component of the exam.

India

Standard XII – Exemption granted with a minimum grade equivalent to a C in each area/component of the examination.

Macau

Exame Unificado de Acesso / Unified Entrance Examination – Exemption granted with a grade equal to or higher than 50% of the maximum score in each area/component of the examination.

Mexico

EXANI II (pelo Centro Nacional de Evaluación para la Educación Superior – Ceneval) – Exemption granted upon achieving a grade equal to or higher than 50% of the maximum score in each area/component of the examination.

Turkey

YKS (Yükseköğretim Kurumları Sınavı) Higher Education Institutions Examination) – Exemption granted upon achieving a grade equal to or higher than 180 points in each area/component assessed.

Various Countries

IB-DP (International Baccalaureate – Diploma Programme) – Exemption granted upon passing with a minimum score of 3 points in each of the six main subjects of the IBDP curriculum.

SAT – Exemption granted upon achieving a score equal to or higher than 50% of the maximum score in each area/component of the exam.

ANNEX IV: Calculation of the ranking score

The final ranking score is calculated based on the candidate's profile and for each of the degrees to which they have applied. Candidates may be exempted from written exams in accordance with points 4.3, 4.4, and 4.5 of this Notice, the list of which is included in Annex II.

If the entrance exams and/or national/state/international exams do not allow for the identification of the scientific areas examined, the final overall classification obtained in the exams in question will be considered.

The final classification for the purposes of seriation is calculated by directly converting the classification of the equivalent test, required for access to the degree in question, from the IB-DP scale (1-7 rating) to the Portuguese scale (0-20 rating). In the case of a degree that requires the combination of two Tests, the calculation of the final classification must be carried out by converting the classification of each test to the Portuguese scale, then calculating the arithmetic average calculated up to the tenths and, when necessary, by rounding to the immediately upper or lower tenth, as the excess is equal/higher or lower than 5 hundredths.

The reference table for the conversion of the International Baccalaureate (IB) classification system to the Portuguese Educational System (SEP) is the result of the application of the provisions of Article 20º-A of D. L. nº 296-a/98, of 25/09, in its current wording, for the purpose of replacing entrance exams, using the formula contained in the CNAES Deliberation Nº 44/2023, of 09/01..
